2026 BOOKING INFORMATION, UPDATED CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICIES:

- The campground is open from June 1st to September 30th.
- The Molas Lake Campground Office and Store is open 7 AM – 7 PM, seven days a week, from June 1st to September 30th.

- Each site is unique in size and characteristics. Please review each individual site description carefully, BEFORE MAKING YOUR RESERVATION, to ensure it fits your needs. Be careful and ensure your RV, trailer, vehicle(s), or tent(s) will fit on your selected site.
- IF YOU INCORRECTLY BOOK A CAMPSITE THAT IS NOT APPROPRIATE (for your RV/trailer/tent(s) sizes), WE CANNOT GUARANTEE THAT WE CAN ACCOMMODATE A DIFFERENT CAMPSITE AT CHECK-IN - we do sell out for most of the summer. Please email us with any questions (info@molaslake.com).
- Our secure online reservation system allows campers to reserve a campsite by selecting the Campsite Number within the chosen site TYPE (site Category).
- When booking, select by Camping Dates & Campsite Number to view availability. PLEASE BE FLEXIBLE! If your stay is longer than a particular site is available, we encourage you to make multiple reservations and switch sites for a more extended stay.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. OUR CAMPING, CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICIES MAY HAVE CHANGED SINCE YOUR LAST VISIT:

- If the Town of Silverton cancels your reservation due to COVID-19, there will be a 100% refund.
- If you cancel your reservation:
 - 1) No refunds for any cancellations that are after 90 days of creating your reservation;
 - 2) If your cancellation date is less than 90 days from the date the reservation was created and at least 7 days before your arrival date, we will issue a 50% refund;
 - 3) There will be no refunds for any cancellations that are less than 7 days before your arrival date;
 - 4) Refunds will be made to the credit card used to book the reservation.
- To cancel or change your reservation, please Email Us (info@molaslake.com) and specify that you booked your reservation online with the reservation identification code. PLEASE PROVIDE YOUR PHONE NUMBER IN YOUR EMAIL SO WE CAN CALL YOU IF THE INTERNET IS DOWN!
- PLEASE ensure you book an appropriate campsite for what you are bringing. IF YOU INCORRECTLY BOOK A CAMPSITE THAT IS NOT APPROPRIATE (for your RV/trailer/tent(s) sizes), WE CANNOT GUARANTEE THAT WE CAN ACCOMMODATE A DIFFERENT CAMPSITE AT CHECK-IN - we do sell out for most of the summer. CAMPING POLICIES FOR ALL SITE CATEGORIES AND CAMPSITES:

- Driving over vegetation or removing trees or limbs to fit an RV or trailer onto a site is strictly prohibited.
- Cutting or picking up wood at Molas Lake Campground to burn in campfires or grills is strictly prohibited.
- **Check-In: 1:00 PM. Check-Out: 11:00 AM.** For late arrival arrangements, if you plan to arrive after 7:00 PM, your site number and last name will be listed and marked on a map on the office's front door. Just come back in the morning to grab your paperwork! All campsites must be vacated by 11:00 AM on Check-Out day.
- At least **one adult** (person at least 18 years old) must be in your party and present at check-in.
- Maximum number of **guests per campsite is 8** (if you have more, reserve more than one site).
- Maximum number of **tents per campsite is 2** (if you have more, reserve more than one site).
- Maximum number of **vehicles per campsite is 2** (if you have more, reserve more than one site).

- You must read our [**UPDATED RESERVATION & CANCELLATION POLICIES**](#) on the www.MolasLake.com website before making a reservation. **By making a reservation, you agree to all Molas Lake Campground policies.** A printable PDF of our Policies can be downloaded and printed from www.molaslake.com/campingreservations.html.
- There are **no on-site water or electricity hookups available**. There is **potable water located next to the office** that you can use to fill up your water containers. RVs can fill up to 30 gallons of potable water, but no more. Dump stations are available within the Town of Silverton, just 5 miles (10 minutes drive) away. The fee is typically around \$10.
- There is **no internet connectivity** and **limited cell service** within the campground.
- **Firewood** is available for sale from Molas Lake Store. Due to ecological concerns and the appearance of invasive species, campers are strictly prohibited from bringing firewood from out-of-state. Cutting or picking up wood at Molas Lake Campground to burn in campfires or grills is strictly prohibited.
- **Hot water shower facilities** (with electrical outlets) are available for \$5.00 per token. Most campers will buy one token per shower. The campground bathrooms do not have any running water. Shower availability is not guaranteed from September 15th to the season's close.
- Generators must be reasonably quiet and are **ONLY ALLOWED in the Lake-View Ultra RV and Rock Cliff Standard RV** campsites during the hours of 8 AM to 8 PM.

GENERAL & DAY USE POLICIES:

- **DAY USE HOURS:** Molas Lake Park is open for day users from "dawn-to-dusk."
- **PICNIC & BBQ:** Four-day use areas are available free of charge, first-come, first-serve. Each area has a BBQ grill and picnic table.
- **WOOD:** Molas Lake Store sells firewood. In the interest of forest health, no out-of-state wood is allowed to prevent the spread of forest pathogens and disease. **Cutting or picking up wood at Molas Lake Campground to burn in campfires or grills is strictly prohibited.**
- **TOILETS:** Clean, vault-style toilets are located near the day use parking areas.
- **PETS:** Pets are welcome at Molas Lake. **Dogs must be leashed at all times in Molas Lake Park and Campground.** They must not bother anglers or be left unattended. **Owners must pick up all pet waste and dispose of it properly (not in bathrooms)** to ensure trails, fishing areas, day use picnic areas, and campground are clean.
- **FISHING:** There is **no fee** to fish at Molas Lake. All anglers **need valid Colorado fishing licenses.** Our [fishing web page](#) has more information on where to buy fishing licenses.

You'll need to supply your own fishing equipment. **Aquatic live bait is prohibited.** Rainbow and brown trout are the most common species in the lake. The **fish limit is 4 fish per person/per license.**

- **FISH CLEANING:** Cleaning of fish is **only allowed at the fish cleaning station**, and all unwanted fish byproducts must be bagged and discarded in the dumpster. The fish cleaning station is located by the Molas Lake Office on the west (left) side of the garage. Do not clean fish in the lake.
- **BOATING:** Bring your own non-motorized hand-launched watercraft or rent one at the Molas Lake Store. Electric trolling boats are allowed on Molas Lake. The [Molas Lake Store rents kayaks, SUPs, and a rowboat](#). Boats must be launched at the boat ramp.
- **HIKING or BIKING:** Molas Lake Park provides access to the Colorado Trail and several other Molas Lake and Molas Pass area trails. See our [hiking web page](#) for more information.
- **NOT ALLOWED:** Molas Lake Park does not allow swimming in Molas Lake, ATVs, drones, or unleashed pets.
