## FOR ALL SITE CATEGORIES AND CAMPSITES:

- **Driving over vegetation or removing trees or limbs to fit an RV or trailer onto a site is strictly prohibited.**
- **Cutting or picking up wood at Molas Lake Campground to burn in campfires or grills is strictly prohibited.**
- **Check-In: 1:00 PM. Check-Out: 11:00 AM.** For late arrival arrangements, if you plan to arrive after 7:00 PM, your site number and last name will be listed and marked on a map on the office's front door. Just come back in the morning to grab your paperwork! All campsites must be vacated by 11:00 AM on Check-Out day.
- At least **one adult** (person at least 18 years old) must be in your party and present at check-in. Maximum number of **guests per campsite is 8** (if you have more, reserve more than one site). Maximum number of **tents per campsite is 2** (if you have more, reserve more than one site). Maximum number of **vehicles per campsite is 2** (if you have more, reserve more than one site). - There are **no on-site water or electricity hookups available**. There is **potable water located next to the office** that you can use to fill up your water containers. RVs can fill up to 30 gallons of potable water, but no more. Dump stations are available within the Town of Silverton, just 5 miles (10 minutes' drive) away. The fee is typically around \$10.
- There is **no internet connectivity** and **limited cell service** within the campground.
- **Firewood** is available for sale from Molas Lake Store. Due to ecological concerns and the appearance of invasive species, campers are strictly prohibited from bringing firewood from out-of-state. Cutting or picking up wood at Molas Lake Campground to burn in campfires or grills is strictly prohibited.
- **Hot water shower facilities** (with electrical outlets) are available for \$5.00 per token. Most campers will buy one token per shower. The campground bathrooms do not have any running water. Shower availability is not guaranteed from September 15th to the season's close.
- Generators must be reasonably quiet and are **ONLY ALLOWED in the Lake-View Ultra RV and Rock Cliff Standard RV campsites** during the hours of 8 AM to 8 PM.

## DESCRIPTIONS OF SITE CATEGORIES AND CAMPSITES:

### Premium Water View

Premium Water View small RV or tent campsites feature outstanding views of Molas Lake. These are our closest sites to the lake. There are 15 individual PREMIUM WATER VIEW SMALL RV/TENT campsites.

These sites all have gravel parking, a tent pad or all-dirt surface, a fire pit, and a picnic table. All of these sites (EXCEPT P31, P37, and P40) are suitable for tents, pop-up campers, and small RVs (motorhomes under 23 ft or trailers under 20 ft; some are limited to 14 ft). Sites P31, P37, and P40 cannot accommodate RVs or trailers of any size. **Generators are not allowed in these sites.** The campground map, showing the orientation of the campsites, and a document with brief descriptions of individual sites are available at [www.molaslake.com/campingreservations.html](http://www.molaslake.com/campingreservations.html).

- **Site# P30** - This lakefront site is located on the North end of Molas Lake. It is graveled and suitable for RVs or a pop-up trailer **up to 20 ft**. It is also a very nice site for one large wall tent or two smaller tents — ideal for fishing directly from camp. It has good morning sun and mountain views across the lake. This is a good site for kayaking or paddle boards, too.

- **Site# P31** - Site P31 is the smallest Premium Water View site and cannot accommodate RVs or trailers of any size. Located on the north end of the lake, this site is located directly on the water and has great views. **It is suitable for car/tent camping but not RVs**. As with P30, this site will accommodate one large wall tent or 2 smaller tents. Ideal for fishing, SUPing, or kayaking directly from camp. It has good morning sun and mountain views.
- **Site# P32** - This waterfront site on the North end of the lake is suitable for **RVs up to 23 ft or pop-ups to 20 ft**. It also works well for car/tent camping. While no trees are on this site, it is graveled and ideal for those wanting to fish right from their camp. It has good morning sun and mountain views. This is a good site for kayaking or paddle boards, too.
- **Site# P33** - While not directly on the lake, P33 sits on a knoll directly above it with views of the lake to the south and mountains in all directions. It is suitable for **RVs up to 23 ft and pop-ups up to 20 ft**. It also works well for car/tent camping. It has good morning and evening sun. This site works great combined with P34; the knoll overlooks the lake and would be all yours.
- **Site# P35** - This site overlooks the lake and has great views with space that can accommodate **RVs up to 23 ft, trailers up to 20 ft**, and can fit all tent sizes. Located on a small hill close to P34 and P33. P33 and P34 are great options for a larger group when combined with P35.
- **Site# P34** - While not directly on the lake, P34 is located on a knoll above the lake and is a bit more private with a few trees, views of the lake to the south, and mountains in all directions. It is suitable for **RVs up to 23 ft and pop-ups up to 20 ft**. It also works well for car/tent camping. It has a graveled parking area and space to set up tents. This site works great for small groups when combined with P33; the knoll overlooks the lake and would be all yours.
- **Site# P36** - This site sits just off the waterfront and has a few trees. It has a graveled parking area suitable for **RVs up to 20 ft and pop-ups up to 20 ft**. P36 is also good for car/tent camping, with room for one medium wall tent or two smaller tents on the gravel pad. It has good morning sun and mountain views. It shares lake access with site P37 and could be combined with it for small groups.
- **Site# P37** - This site sits on the water just below its small graveled parking area. It has no trees, but its large tent sites are on grass and have good sun all day long. Mountain views in all directions. **Not suitable for RVs or pop-ups**. Good site for fishing, kayaking, or paddle boards. Shares lake access with P36 and could be combined with P36 for small groups.
- **Site# P38** - This small site sits between two large trees and is right on the water with mountain views across the lake to the south. Suitable for one medium size wall tent. While **not ideal, you can fit one RV/ pop-up or teardrop camper up to 14 ft** in the dirt parking area. Great for truck campers. Good site for fishing, kayaking, or paddle boards. This can be combined with P39 for a smaller group.
- **Site# P39** - This smaller site sits directly next to P38 and right above the lake, with trees on both sides and mountain views across the lake to the south. Suitable for one large wall tent or two small tents, you can also fit **one teardrop or pop-up camper up to 15 ft** in the dirt parking area. Good site for hammocks and fishing, kayaking, or paddle boards. This site can be combined with P38 for a small group.
- **Site# P40** - This nicely treed site sits above the lake and has mountain views to the west across the lake. **Not suitable for RVs or pop-ups**, this site will accommodate one large wall tent or two medium-sized tents. Ideal for fishing directly from camp. Good site for hammocks, kayaking, or paddle boards. Site#16 can be combined with P40 for groups that want to be closer together; Site#16 is located directly across the road from P40. Site#16 can be combined with P40 for groups that want to be closer together; #16 is located directly across the road from P40.
- **Site# P41** - A nicely treed site that sits above the lake with westerly mountain views/sunsets across the lake. While not ideal, this site will accommodate **one RV/pop-up up to 14 ft** above the tent site parallel to the road. It is better suited for one large wall tent or two medium-sized tents. Good site for hammocks, fishing, kayaking, or paddle boards.
- **Site# P42** - This site sits atop a hill with mountain views in all directions and access to the lake just below the tent sites. While not ideal for RVs/pop-ups due to having to back into the site, those who are

comfortable backing in on top of a hill will love this site. It can accommodate **one small RV, pop-up, or trailer up to 15 ft.** Most tents will fit on this site. This site works well for small and large groups when combined with P43 and P44.

- **Site# P43** - This site sits close to the lake with mountain views across the lake to the west. It can accommodate **one pop-up or trailer up to 15 ft.** It is also suitable for one large wall tent and one medium tent. P43 has lake access with P42. Good site for fishing, kayaking, or paddle boards. This site works well for smaller and larger groups when combined with P42 and P44.
- **Site# P44** - This site was recently enlarged and is suitable for **one 23 ft RV or one pop-up/trailer up to 14 ft** or 2 tents. It can be combined with Site# P43 for groups.

### Lake-View Ultra RV

The LAKE-VIEW ULTRA RV campsites sit on a hill overlooking Molas Lake with spectacular views looking east into the San Juan Mountains and can accommodate motorhomes, trailers, and fifth-wheels of any size. The start of the lake loop and Colorado Trail hiking trails are located directly behind these sites. All four URV sites are freshly graveled, and a short dirt road leads to them.

Each site is outfitted with gravel parking and either a tent pad or all-dirt surface, as well as a fire pit and picnic table. URV4 has a large ponderosa pine located on it; URV2 & URV3 do not have trees. URV1 is also an excellent tent camping site, with great views looking east into the San Juan Mountains, and has a large ponderosa pine tree. URV sites are suitable for most RVs and have good morning sun. REASONABLY QUIET generators are allowed in these sites from 8 AM-8 PM. There are only four of these sites (URV1, URV2, URV3, and URV4), so they fill up fast.

### Rock Cliff Standard RV

These extra-large sites sit within a unique geological formation; they are NOT "lake-side" or "lake-view" sites. All of our standard RV sites can accommodate motorhomes, trailers, and fifth-wheels of any size, including the largest RVs and associated camp setup.

Although not ideal, they are also suitable for car/truck/SUV/tent camping. Each site is outfitted with gravel parking or all-dirt surface, as well as a fire pit and picnic table. Sites# 50 and 51 have lake views, while Sites# 53-57 have great mountain views. **All sites are back-in.** REASONABLY QUIET generators are allowed in these sites from 8 AM-8 PM.

## Small RV or Tent (generally motorhomes under 23 ft or trailers/pop-ups under 20 ft – see site descriptions)

There are 29 individual SMALL RV/TENT campsites. Each site has a gravel parking and tent pad or all-dirt surface, as well as a fire pit with a cooking grill and picnic table. These sites are generally suitable for tents, pop-up campers, and small RVs (motorhomes under 23 ft or trailers under 20 ft), WITH SEVERAL EXCEPTIONS – READ DESCRIPTIONS CAREFULLY. **Generators are not allowed in these sites.**

\* Price is **\$50/night**, plus 10.4% tax. During the July 4th and Labor Day Holiday periods, prices are increased by 50% to \$75/night.

- **Site# 1** - Mid-morning sun and mountain views to the west are featured in this graveled site, which is the closest site to the office/store and showers. It is suitable for **RVs up to 23 ft** in length, **pop-ups up to 20 ft**, or large tents. You also have a lake view across the road.
- **Site# 2** - This is a pull-through site. It is good for all **RVs up to 23 ft** in length, **pop-ups up to 20 ft**. The site's graveled area works well for tents of all sizes, too. The sun reaches you by mid-morning, and you have mountain views to the west.
- **Site# 3** - This smaller graveled site is **not suitable for RVs** but is great for one car/SUV and one medium-sized tent. Morning sun and somewhat private. Great for truck campers and smaller **pop-ups up to 14'** with one vehicle. Perfect for a hammock.
- **Site# 4** - Located next to a small grove of trees to the northeast, this site might not get the early sun, but it has mountain views to the west and late evening sun. This graveled site fits **RVs up to 23 ft.**, **pop-up trailers up to 20 ft**, or tents of all sizes.
- **Site# 5** - Located in a small grove of trees, this site is one of our most private sites. It gets late sun with mountain views to the northwest. There are about six steps down from the graveled parking area to the open area/tent sites. Limited to **RVs /pop-up trailers up to 15 ft**, and tents of all sizes.
- **Site# 6** - This lightly treed site gets early morning sun and has mountain views to the north and east. It has a large graveled parking area that accommodates vehicles/**RVs up to 23 ft**, **pop-up trailers up to 20 ft**, or 2 SUVs/trucks with either a large wall tent or two small- to medium-sized tents. Sites# 6, 7, & 8 can also be reserved as part of our "large group" site at the regular per-site rate.
- **Site# 7** - This open graveled site accommodates the largest RVs we allow in the Small RV/Tent sites, **RVs up to 23 ft.** or **pop-up trailers up to 20 ft**. This site is sunny all day and has ample room for two large tents either on the gravel or located just off the gravel to the north. Sites# 6, 7, & 8 can also be reserved as part of our "large group" site at the regular per-site rate.
- **Site# 8** - This open graveled site accommodates the largest RVs we allow in the Small RV/Tent sites, **RVs up to 23 ft.** or **pop-up trailers up to 20 ft**. This site is sunny all day and has ample room for two large tents either on the gravel or located just off the gravel to the north and east. Sites# 6, 7, & 8 can also be reserved as part of our "large group" site at the regular per-site rate.
- **Site# 9** - Located in a small grove of trees, this all-dirt site offers great camping for one large wall tent and one medium-sized tent. It can also accommodate **one small pop-up or teardrop trailer up to 14 ft**. Can be combined with Site#10 or both Sites #10 and #11 to make a great small group site.

- **Site# 10** - Located in a small grove of trees, this all-dirt site offers great camping for one large wall tent or two medium-sized tents. When combined with Site#9 and/or Site#11, it makes a great small-group site. Suitable for truck and SUV camping and **one small pop-up or RV up to 15 ft.**
- **Site# 11** - This mixed surface site has a graveled area that can fit two cars/trucks or **one pop-up or teardrop camp trailer up to 15 ft** and its tow vehicle. Its dirt tent sites will accommodate two small-sized tents or one large wall tent. It makes a nice group site when combined with Site#10 and Site#9.
- **Site# 12** - This all-dirt site is in the trees and will work well for those car/SUV camping or those bringing a pop-up or teardrop camp **trailer up to 20 ft.** It also works well for one large wall tent or two medium-sized tents. It also has views of the lake.
- **Site# 13** - This mixed gravel/dirt site has a couple of trees but is mostly open. It has a nice open space behind the small graveled tent site and can accommodate **RVs up to 23 ft** and **pop-ups/trailers up to 20 ft** on the dirt parking area.
- **Site# 14** - This mixed gravel/dirt site is located on the edge of a grove of trees and can handle one large wall tent and a medium-sized tent. It will also work for **one RV up to 23 ft** or a **pop-up/teardrop camper up to 20 ft** and its tow vehicle. Combined with Site#15, it makes a nice small group site.
- **Site# 15** - This site is located in a grove of trees that provide some privacy. It is most suited for tent camping but could also work for a **small camper trailer up to 14 ft**, but the graveled parking spot can be **difficult to back into**. When combined with Site#14, it makes a nice small group site.
- **Site# 16** - This nice graveled site is located in the trees directly across from Site#P40 and can be used in conjunction with P40 as a small group site. It is most suitable for car/SUV camping and will accommodate one large wall tent or two smaller tents. This site has a view of the lake and eagles sometime fly right over this site. It is **not suitable for RVs/trailers.** Sites 16, 17A, and 17B can be combined for small groups.
- **Site# 17A** - This nice dirt site is located in a small open area in the trees. It would work well for car/SUV/tent camping but could also work with a **pop-up/trailer up to 20 ft** or **RV up to 23 ft.** Sites 16, 17A, and 17B can be combined for small groups.
- **Site# 17B** - This small site is only suitable for one car/SUV/truck and one medium to small size tent. Sites 16, 17A, and 17B can be combined for small groups.
- **Site# 18A** - This secluded dirt site sits up a short rocky road on the edge of a grove of trees. The **road is not suitable for RVs.** It would be best for car/truck/SUV tent camping, although you could take a **SMALL pop-up or camp trailer up to 14 ft** to it. This campsite sits across from Site#18B and can be combined for a small group site.
- **Site# 18B** - This site is located across from 18A and at the top of a short rocky hill that is **not suitable for RVs.** Works well when combined with Site#18A for small groups. It sits in the open on the edge of a grove of trees. It is best suited for car/truck/SUV tent camping, although you could take a **SMALL pop-up or camp trailer up to 14 ft** to it.
- **Site# 19** - This nicely treed site is most suitable for most tent sizes with parking for two cars/trucks. It has a flat area that is suitable for **RVs up to 23 ft and pop-ups up to 14 ft.**
- **Site# 20A** - A nice and somewhat private site with morning sun and room for large wall tents or a **pop-up camper up to 14 ft.** This campsite is at the top of a short, steep road. When combined with Site# 20B, it works well for groups.
- **Site# 20B** - Located next to Site# 20A, this site is suitable for large wall tents or a **pop-up camper up to 14 ft.** When combined with Site# 20A, it works well for groups. This is an open campsite with no trees. It has small hills on three sides and amazing mountain views with morning sun. It is situated at the top of a short, steep road.
- **Site# 21** - A large treed site with room for **RVs up to 23 ft and pop-ups up to 20 ft**, or two large tents with two cars/SUVs. Can be combined with Sites# 22-24 for large groups.
- **Site# 22** - This is a small site located close to Sites# 21-24. Suitable for one medium-sized tent and one car/SUV. Can be combined with Sites# 21, 23, and 24 for large groups. It has a flat area that is suitable for

**RVs up to 23 ft and pop-ups up to 14 ft.**

- **Site# 23** - A somewhat open site that is suitable for car/truck camping with large tents or one **RV/teardrop/pop-up camper up to 20 ft.** Can be combined with Sites# 21, 22, and 24 for large groups.
- **Site# 24** - This campsite is good for campers with cars or trucks and who have small- to medium-sized tents. This site also accommodates **one small pop-up or teardrop camper up to 15 ft.** Can be combined with Sites# 21, 22, and 23 for large groups.
- **Site# 25** - Located on a small pull-in this private site sits in the open with a small pond on one side and the lake just across the road. Suitable for **one small RV or pop-up/teardrop trailer up to 20 ft.** This campsite also works well for one car/truck with one medium-sized tent.
- **Site# 26** - This large site accommodates tents of all sizes and most vehicles. This site is suitable for **RVs up to 23 ft and pop-ups up to 14 ft.** To get to this campsite, there is a hill with a sharp crest that can hang up RVs and camp trailers.

## Disability-Accessible-Site

This extra-large campsite is suitable for campers in an RV of up to 23 feet in length, tent campers, or pop-up campers. It includes a concrete surface with level, paved access to a clean vault-style toilet. Guests may be asked to show a disability parking permit.
